Let's Begin

Before you begin read all instructions. Sew using an accurate Seam Allowances and Assembly Line Method to construct this quilt. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam allowance throughout this project. Press seams in direction of arrows as indicated in each diagram.

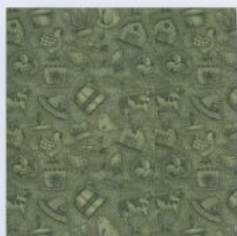

Making the Blocks

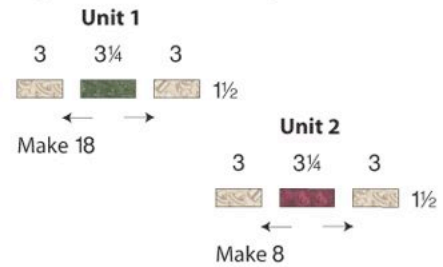
1. Sew one 5" Fabric A square between two 1" x 5" Fabric D pieces as shown. Press. Sew this unit between two 1" x 6" Fabric D pieces. Press. Make thirteen.



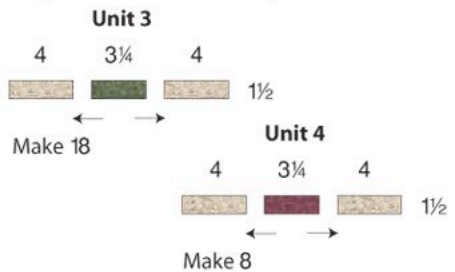
2. Sew one unit from step 1 between two Fabric B triangles, triangles will extend past raw edges of square. Press toward triangles. Sew this unit between two Fabric B triangles as shown. Press. Make thirteen. Square unit to 8 1/4". *Note: Place triangle fabric against sewing machine feed dogs to prevent bias edge from stretching.*



3. Sew one 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" Fabric E piece between two 1 1/2" x 3" Fabric B pieces as shown. Press. Make eighteen. Sew one 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" Fabric D piece between two 1 1/2" x 3" Fabric B pieces. Press. Make eight.



4. Sew one 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" Fabric E piece between two 1 1/2" x 4" Fabric B pieces as shown. Press. Make eighteen. Sew one 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" Fabric D piece between two 1 1/2" x 4" Fabric B pieces. Press. Make eight.



5. Sew one unit from step 2 between two matching units from step 3. Press. Sew this unit between two matching units from step 4 as shown. Press. Make thirteen and label nine Block 1 and four Block 2 as shown.



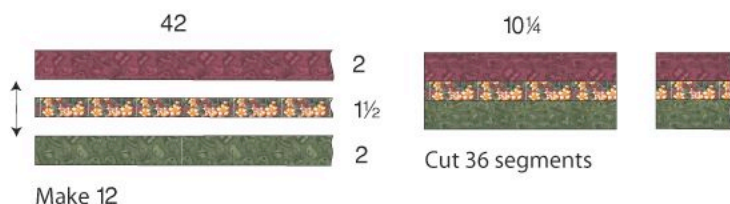

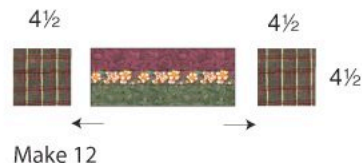

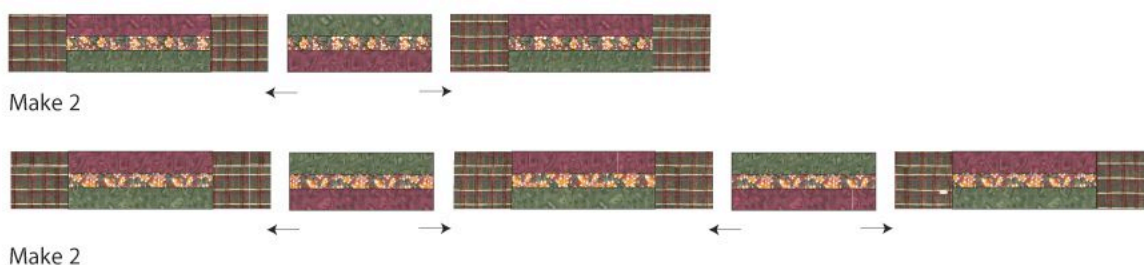
- 6.** Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" Fabric C strip between one 2" x 42" Fabric D and one 2" x 42" Fabric E strips as shown. Press. Make twelve. From strip set, cut thirty-six $10\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide segments as shown.



- 7.** Sew one strip set from step 6 between two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares as shown. Press. Make twelve.

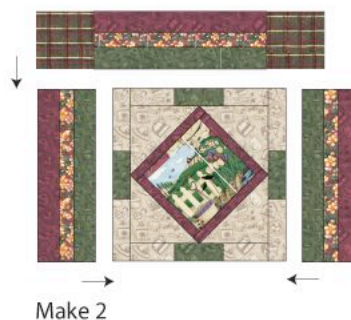


- 8.** Sew one unit from step 6 between two units from step 7 as shown. Press. Make two. Arrange and sew three units from step 7 to two units from step 6 as shown. Press. Make two.

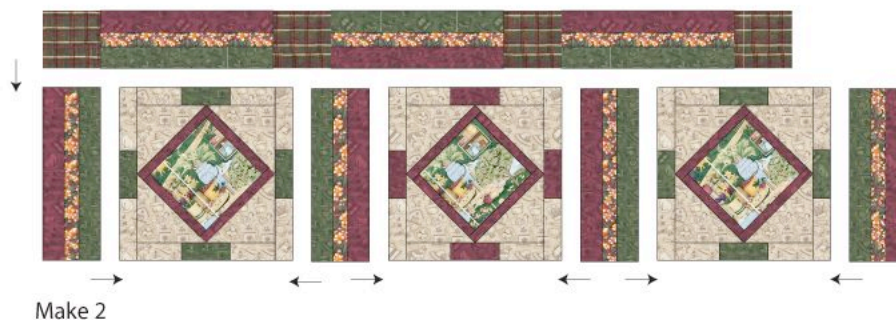


- 9.** Referring to layout on page 4, arrange on design wall or floor units from steps 5-8 and Fabric E corner and side setting triangles, checking orientation of strip sets.

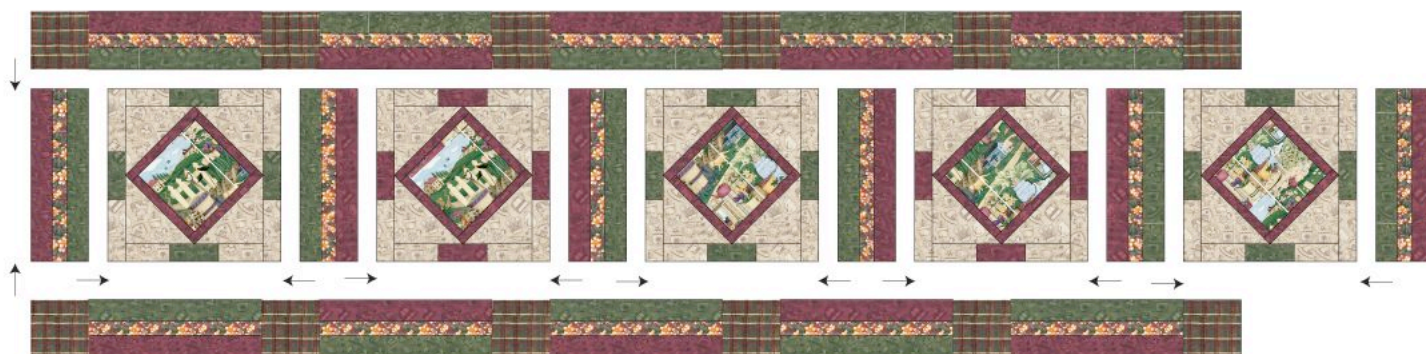
- 10.** *Note: To make assembly easier after each of the following steps, reposistion sewn row in quilt layout. This will help keep blocks in order.* Sew one Block 1 from step 5 between two units from step 6 as shown. Press. Sew this unit to one unit from step 7. Press. Make two.



- 11.** Sew four units from step 6 to two block 1's and one block 2 as shown. Press. Sew this unit to one smaller unit from step 8. Press. Make two.



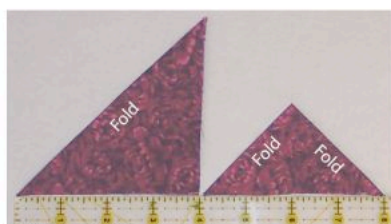
12. Sew six units from step 6 to three Block 1's and two Block 2's as shown. Press. Sew this unit between two larger units from step 8. Press.



13 Referring to layout, sew rows from steps 10-12, corner and side setting triangles together in diagonal rows. Press. Sew rowstogether to make quilt top. Press.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Fold 4" Fabric F squares twice diagonally to make Prairie Points as shown. Press.

2. Referring to photo below arrange twenty-one prairie points to each quilt side. Place double folded edge of prairie point between single folded edges of next piece adjusting length as needed, triangle edge should meet at corners. Sew using $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide seam. Press away from center.

3. Cut backing into two equal pieces. Sew pieces together to make one 81" x 81" approximate backing piece. Press backing and quilt top

trimming all excess threads from quilt.

Layer and baste backing, batting and quilt top together. Hand or machine quilt as desired, leaving 1" from all edges free of stitching.

4. Fold prairie points back toward center to reveal quilt top edge. Trim batting even with quilt top edge being careful not to cut backing fabric. Trim backing fabric 1" larger than quilt top. Fold prairie points to outside edge making sure seam is between top and backing fabric. Turn under backing fabric and stitch in place covering seam. Add quilting as needed.
