Materials List

Fat quarters of the following for crazy patchwork blocks:

Hike-01 Red	Hike-07 Orange
Hike-01 Olive	Hike-07 Forest
Hike-02 Olive	Hike-05 Cream for block centers
Hike-02 Gold	Hike-06 Cream for block centers
Hike-03 Yellow	Hike-07 Cream for block centers
Hike-03 Olive	Hike-05 Brick for leaves and blocks
Hike-04 Green	Hike-06 Khaki for leaves and blocks
Hike-04 Brown	Hike-07 Yellow for leaves and blocks
Hike-04 Red	
Hike-05 Weed	2 yds Hike-01 Green for borders and blocks
Hike-05 Moss	1/2 yd Hike-05 Black for borders
Hike-05 Topaz	4 yds Hike-03 Rust for backing and blocks
Hike-07 Green	Fusible web for appliqué
Hike-06 Gold	Threads to match leaf fabrics
Hike-06 Weed	Dark brown thread for leaf stems and veins
Hike-07 Pistachio	Double bed size cotton batting

Cutting Directions

1. Using Hike-01 Green fabric cut (7) 6-1/2" x length of fabric border strips. Cut (7) 2-1/4" x length of fabric binding strips. Using Hike-05 Black, cut (6) strips 1-1/2" x width of fabric for narrow borders.
2. Cut (6) 7" squares, Hike-06 Beige, (5) 7" squares Hike-07 Cream, (5) 7" squares Hike-05 Cream.
3. Trace 5 leaves A, (6) leaves B and (5) leaves C onto fusible web. Iron fusible web for leaves A on Hike-05 Brick, leaves B on Hike-07 Yellow and, and 5 leaves C on Hike-06 Khaki. Cut leaves out and press onto background fabrics.
4. Using left over leaf fabrics, the fat quarters, and fat quarters cut from the border and backing fabrics, cut (1) 2-1/2" x 22" strip and (1) 3-1/2" x 22" strip from each fat quarter.

Sewing Directions

5. Fuse leaves to the 7" squares as follows: leaves A to Hike-07 Cream squares, leaves B to Hike-06 Beige, and leaves C to Hike-05 Cream. Using a matching thread and a small stitch, sew a scant 1/8" from raw edge of each leaf. When each leaf is sewn in placed, use your rotary cutter and ruler to trim the 7" square into a free form 5-sided shape. Each will be slightly different in shape and size.

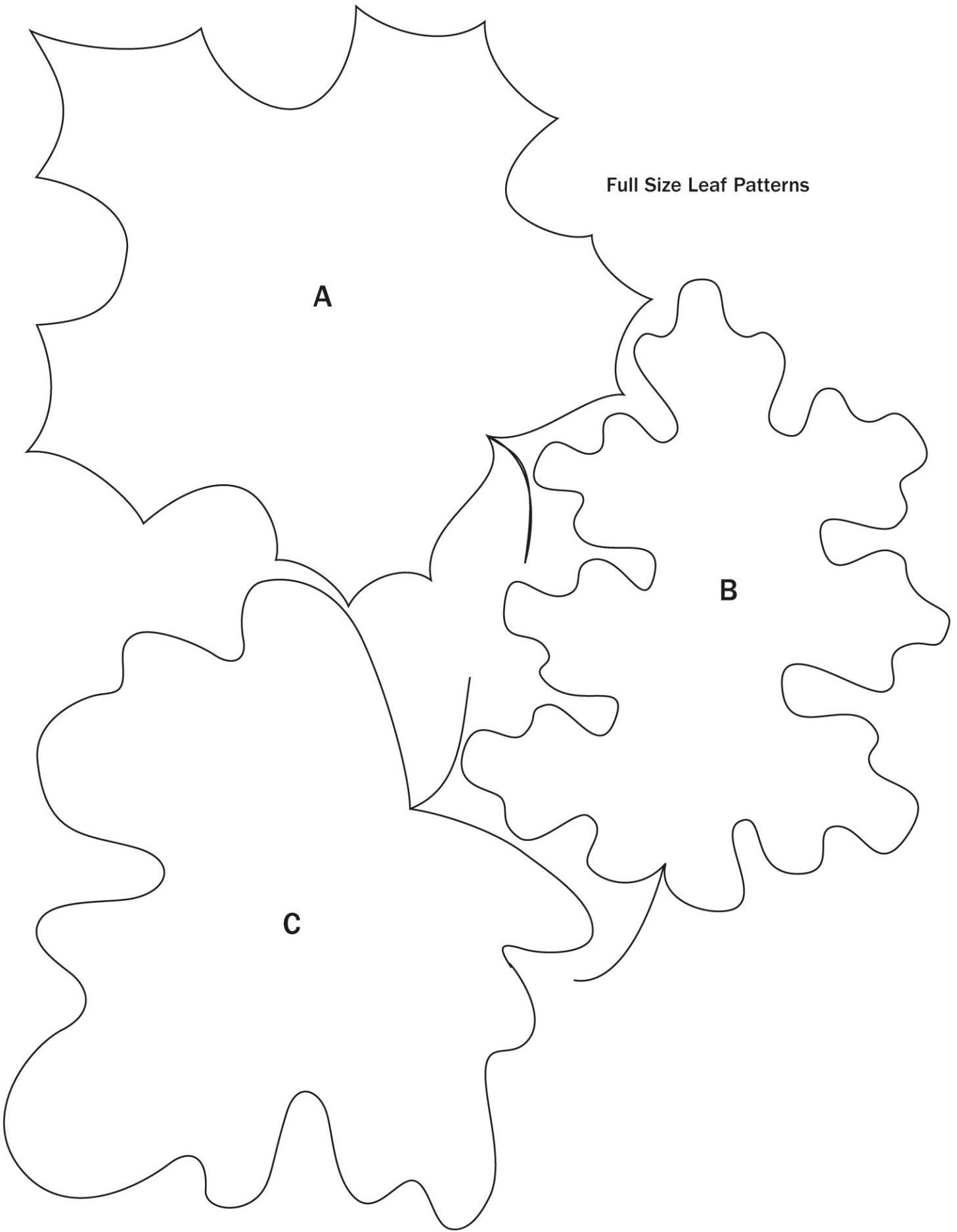

Crazy Log Cabin Block

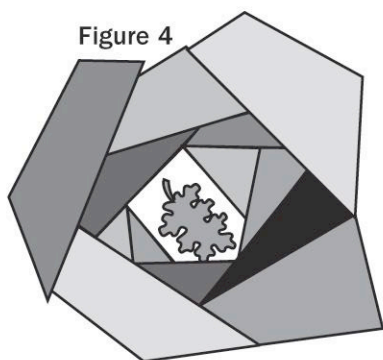

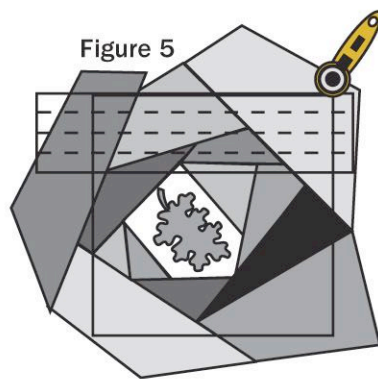

6. Following the diagrams, start adding the crazy patches by sewing random strips first to one side of each center leaf block. Fold out the strip and press the seam. Use your rotary cutter to trim the strip to the shape of the leaf center. Continue adding strips until your block can be trimmed to a precise 12-1/2" square. You will need to cut additional strips from the fat quarters as you finish the blocks and you may want to cut some of them wider or narrower than the strips you started with. Make 16 blocks.

7. When all 16 blocks are finished use the dark brown thread to stitch in the stems and veins. Use a small, straight stitch and sew in a slightly curved line from a position about 1" from the bottom of the leaf almost to the tip of the leaf. Sew back over the same stitching line, adding veins that branch off the main vein as you sew back to the bottom of the leaf. Each vein will be of a double line of stitching when you sew all the way out to the end of the beginning stem line.

Quilt Assembly

8. Sew the 16 blocks into 4 rows of 4 blocks each. Refer to the color photo for the placement of the leaf colors. A gold leaf is in each of the four corners. Sew the rows together.

9. Sew the narrow Hike-05 black borders to opposite sides, then top and bottom of the quilt top.

10. Sew the Hike-01 Green borders to opposite sides, then top and bottom of the quilt.

Finishing

11. Place the quilt backing wrong side up on a flat surface. Add the batting next. Finally, place the quilt top wrong side down on top of the batting. Baste the three layers together. Quilt the layers together.

12. Bind outside edges of quilt by cutting 2-1/4" wide fabric strips. Fold in half lengthwise and press on fold line. Pin and sew raw edges of binding to raw edges of top and quilt. Turn folded edge to back of quilt and stitch in place.



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
